Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

(a) what action is being taken by Department of Official Language to remove disparity between the pay scale of Rs. 7500-12000 of Assistant Director (Official Language

(e) of Central Official Language Service cadre and the pay scale of Rs. 6500-10500 of Assistant Director (Official Language

(e) of Subordinate Offices;

(b) whether any order has been issued to remove the above disparity; and

(c) if not, the reasons therefor ?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI I.D. SWAMI)

(a): At present all Assistant Directors (Official Language) are in the scale of pay of Rs.6500-10,500/-. The Fifth Pay Commission had recommended a scale of pay of Rs.7500-12000/- for 65 Assistant Directors of the Central Secretariat Official Language Service. This recommendation has been accepted and has also been notified by the Government. But this scale has not yet been implemented as the matter regarding giving the same scale to all the Assistant Directors of the Central Secretariat Official Language service is under consideration. The Officers of the subordinate offices are not included in the official Language service. The responsibility to take decision regarding their pay scales lies with the concerned Ministry/Department.
