RECOMMENDATIONS OF PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE ON OFFICIAL LANGUAGE .

3395. SHRI BALKAVI BAIRAGI

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:-

(a) whether Government have accepted the recommendations of the Parliamentary Committee on Official Language to the effect that separate cadres should be established for officers and employees of translation related posts in the subordinate offices so that they may get appropriate promotional opportunities; and

(b) if so, the action taken so far to implement the said recommendations and the future plans in this regard ?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS

(SHRI I.D. SWAMI)

(a) : Govt. has accepted the recommendations of the Parliamentary Committee on Official language, with the amendment that wherever it is possible, cadre of service for the employees entrusted with the translation work in subordinate offices should be constituted and where it is not possible alternative arrangements for their promotion should be made.

(b) : This recommendation of the Parliamentary Committee on Official Language was circulated by the Deptt. of Official Language on 30th December, 1988, in the form of a resolution. Directions on this subject were issued to all the Ministries/Departments by the Deptt. of Official Language, vide its O.M. dated 13th Nov., 1990.

In view of the above, action in this regard is required to be taken by the concerned Ministries/Departments. For the compliance of these directions various Ministries/Departments have been reminded by the Deptt. of Official Language from time to time.
